





#### M E T H O D S

Random Digit Dialing (RDD) methods have been the most efficient and cost-effective means for administering surveys to a representative sample of adults for several decades. However, data from the National Health Interview Survey highlights the growing problem of wireless substitution of landline telephones for survey researchers. Approximately 39.4% of the U.S. population lives in a household with only wireless telephone service (Blumberg and Luke, 2014). The 2012 Mississippi Social Climate Survey of Tobacco Control reduces noncoverage bias due to wireless substitution by including two sampling frames, an RDD frame of households with a landline telephone and an address-based frame that includes all households that receive deliveries from the US Postal Service. Both sample frames represent the civilian, non-institutionalized adult population over age 18. The overall sample was weighted by race, gender, and age based on the most current U.S. Census estimates.


