



MISSISSIPPI INCREASED THE STATE CIGARETTE TAX FROM 18 CENTS TO 68 CENTS ON MAY 15, 2009



- ▶ 2009 Although the increased tax was only in effect for six and a half months during 2009, revenue from the tax increased by 41.2% and per capita consumption decreased by 4.4% from 2008 to 2009.
- ▶ 2020 Revenue from the tax increased by 130% and per capita consumption decreased by 42% from 2008 to 2020.



The data from tax records clearly demonstrates that the 2009 increase in the state cigarette tax has been followed by reduced consumption and increased revenue.
