











#### Current Smokers, 2008

## Design and Methods

Youth Tobacco Survey

Two-Stage Cluster Sample Design

Public Middle and High Schools

### Response Rate

- Public Middle Schools: 63.2%, N=3,906
  - School Response Rate: 82.6%
  - Student Response Rate: 76.5%
- Public High Schools: 58.0%, N=3,598
  - School Response Rate: 80.0%
  - Student Response Rate: 72.5%

#### Models

- Logistic Regression Models
- Outcomes: Trajectory of Smoking
  - Susceptible
  - Experimenter
  - Established Smoker
  - Frequent Smoker

#### **Predictors and Controls**

- Exposure to Actors Smoking on TV and in the Movies
- Grade
- Race
- Gender
- Social and Contextual Influences
